AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02 OF THE TOWN OF BLACK BROOK, POLK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

SECTION 1: The Town Board of the Town of Black Brook, Wisconsin, does hereby amend Section 2-3-14(e)(d) of Ordinance 2020-02 for the Town of Black Brook to read as follows:

Section 2-3-14(e). Municipal Judge.

d) Election Term – The municipal judge shall be elected at large at the spring election in even numbered years for a term of four (4) years commencing on May 1st next succeeding his or her election.


SECTION II: Severability. Should any section, clause, provision, or portion of this section be adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable by a final order of a court of competent jurisdiction, including all applicable appeals, the remainder of this section shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III: Effective Date. Upon passage and publication, this section shall take effect and be in force as provided by law.
