An Ordinance Establishing for Split Shifts for Election Workers**

SECTION I. Section Created.

Section _____ of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Black Brook is hereby created to read as follows:

SECTION II. Election Officials – Hours of Work

Because Chapter 7.30(1), Wis. Stats., allows for the creation of alternate or two (2) sets of election officials to work at different times on election day, the Town Board authorizes the selection of alternate and/or two (2) sets of election officials to staff the polls on election day. At the discretion of the Town Clerk, the election workers may be employed in two shifts – the first shift from 6:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., and the second shift from 1:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on election day

SECTION III: Severability

If any provision of this Ordinance or any application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional, such a finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

SECTION IV. Effective Date

Following passage by the Town Board, this ordinance shall take effect the day after the date of publication or posting as provided by Sec. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
