

TOWN OF BLACK BROOK
Ordinance Establishing Fire Protection Charges
2017-001

SECTION I. AUTHORITY. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to town boards under Sec. 60.55(2)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes, which allows towns to recover the cost of the fire protection services made to properties located within the town.

SECTION II. LIABILITY FOR COST OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES.

- A. The Town of Black Brook, Polk County, Wisconsin, hereby imposes a charge for each fire protection services made within the limits of the Town of Black Brook. This fee shall not exceed the actual cost to the Town for the fire protection service. If the fire protection services are to real estate located within the Town, the charges shall be imposed on all owners of the real estate to which the particular fire protection services is made. The liability for the charges shall be joint and several as to all owners of the real estate. In the event that a fire protection services is made to personal property located within the Town, such as a vehicle, the charges provided for under this ordinance shall be imposed on all owners of such personal property. The liability for the charges shall be joint and several as to all owners of the personal property.
- B. The fees to be charged shall be pursuant to the fee schedule provided by the fire service which performed the service and which has been approved by the Town of Black Brook Board.

SECTION III. PAYMENT OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE FEE. The fire protection services charges provided for in this Ordinance shall be paid in full to the Clerk of the Town of Black Brook no later than 60 days after the date of the particular fire protection services. The Town of Black Brook shall deliver an invoice for fire protection services to all known property within 30 days of the fire protection services.


SECTION IV. LIABILITY FOR FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES FROM FIRE DEPARTMENTS OTHER THAN THE DEPARTMENT WITH WHICH THE TOWN OF BLACK BROOK CONTRACTS. The Town of Black Brook contracts with the Amery Fire Department and the Village of Deer Park Fire Department for provision of fire and emergency service to the Town. Any property owner within the Town requesting fire protection directly from a fire department other than those listed above shall be responsible for the full costs billed to the Town resulting from the fire protection services. This section shall not apply to the costs of any other department responding at the request of an authorized department under a mutual aid agreement.

SECTION V. UNPAID ACCOUNTS. The failure to pay any invoice for charges incurred pursuant to this ordinance within 60 days of the date of the fire protection services will result in interest being charged at the rate of 1 ½ percent per month from the date of the bill. Any charges for a fire protection services to real estate, plus any accrued interest, that has been unpaid for 90 or more days, as of November 1 of any year, shall become a lien against the real estate and shall be placed on the tax roll as a delinquent special charge under Sec. 66.0627 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION VI. SEVERABILITY. Should any section of provisions of this Ordinance be declared invalid for any reasons be a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION VII. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication or posting as provided by law, pursuant to Sec. 60.80 of the Wisconsin Statutes
