

AMENDMENT TO WISCONSIN UNIFORM DWELLING CODE

TOWN OF BLACK BROOK

Ordinance #11-04

The following paragraph of the original ordinance shall now read as follows:


1.3 SCOPE



The scope of this ordinance includes the construction and inspection of one- and two-family dwellings built since June 1, 1980.

Notwithstanding s. Comm 20.05, the scope also includes the construction and inspection of alterations and additions to one- and two-family dwellings built before June 1, 1980. Because such projects are not under state jurisdiction, petitions for variance and final appeals under ss. Om..20.19 and 20.21, respectively, shall be decided by the municipal board of appeals. Petitions for variance shall be decided per s. Comm. 20.19(Intro) so that equivalency is maintained to the intent of the rule being petitioned. As the board of appeals approves petitions for variance, the chief inspector is granted the power to apply the results to similar circumstances by precedent.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This amendment to said ordinance shall become effective immediately, upon passage and publication as provided by law.
