

AMENDMENT TO WISCONSIN UNIFORM DWELLING CODE

TOWN OF BLACK BROOK

Ordinance # 11-04

The following paragraph of the original ordinance shall now read as follows:

1.6 BUILDING PERMIT REQUIRED

If a person alters a building in excess of **FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000) Dollars** in value in any twelve (12) month period, or builds a new building within the scope of this ordinance, they shall first obtain a building permit for such work from the building inspector. Any structural changes or major changes to mechanical systems that involve extensions shall require permits if over the forgoing thresholds. Restoration or repair of an installation to its previous code-compliant condition as determined by the building inspector is exempted from permit requirements. Residing, re-roofing, finishing of interior surfaces and installation of cabinetry shall be exempted from permit requirements.

EFFECTIVE DATE This amendment to said ordinance shall become effective immediately, upon passage and publication as provided by law.
