Latex Paint Fee:

\$1/less than one Gal. Container
\$2/one gallon container
\$5/five gallon container
Dispose of Latex Paint:

- Recycle empty paint containers.
- Contact trash hauler for disposal.
- Pour into a plasti-lined cardboard box mixed with cat litter or paint drying solvent.



Free Electronic Residential Drop-off

Limit 200 pounds per vehicle.
Over 200 pounds can be brought to the recycling center for 45¢ per pound along with electronics from a business.

• South of Amery across from Country Store.
• Line will enter S. Industrial Park Rd from the North on the west side of highway 46.
